


Driver and Vehicle Requirements for delivery to AWE Aldermaston (West Gate)

AWE Aldermaston is a secure site. To ensure your delivery is successful, please read the [AWE Site Restrictions](#) and the below Driver and Vehicle Requirements BEFORE you book a delivery.

Failure to follow any of the site, driver or vehicle requirements will result in your delivery being refused.

Booking information



Direct delivery to the AWE site only for items that are larger than 1.6m (h) x 1.6m (w) x 2.5m (L).

Deliveries of items below these dimensions **will not** be accepted and should be delivered to Goods In, CTS Logistics, Unit 43 Easter Park, Reading RG7 2PQ.



A **minimum of 24 hours' notice (72 hours for abnormal loads)** is required for direct delivery to AWE. Requests for the next day delivery must be submitted by **15:00**.



No vehicle will be allowed on site for a delivery **before 8:30 or after 15:30**.

Deliveries must be booked in advance.

Delivery times are available from 08:30-16:00.



Drivers must provide a printed copy of the delivery booking confirmation.

The delivery driver and vehicle must match the details you provide. You cannot exchange bookings.



Escorted deliveries can stay on AWE sites for a maximum of 2 hours. If longer, the delivery and driver will need to be booked in separately.



Abuse towards CTS or AWE security will not be tolerated at any point in the booking or delivery process.



If you need to, you can change your booking details up to 24 hours before the delivery time.

Driver requirements

Original Photo ID is required. You will be required to show one of the below when arriving on site:

British Nationals



- Valid signed full passport.
- Valid signed UK driving licence - Driver's Cards are not accepted.



- HM Forces ID Card.



- Police Warrant Card - business cards or Police staff IDs are not accepted.

Other Nationals:

- Valid signed full passport.



Vehicle requirements



All vehicles must be safe to drive and in good working order.



Fixed equipment including Sat-Navs must be declared and switched off at all times whilst on site.



Vehicles must be loaded to leave a 1m gap between items for Ministry of Defence Police (MDP) handlers and search dogs.

Containers, ISOs and cabins must be loaded so they can be accessed by MDP search dogs.



Drivers who hold nationalities from the following countries will be refused access:

Afghanistan / Belarus / China (including Tibet, Hong Kong & Macau) / Iran / North Korea / Russia / Syria / Ukraine

Drivers from additional countries of security concern may be subject to an additional security check.



Local and site speed limits must be followed at all times. The maximum speed limit on AWE internal roads is 20mph.



Industrial parks must not be used as holding areas or for cross-decking of materials. Freight routes via the M4 Reading Services, A4 Bath Road, and the A340 Aldermaston Road offer numerous lay-bys/parking areas.



Please ensure your material is shipped on pallets if you have multiple loose items to deliver.

Multidrop deliveries are not permitted on site - all items should be for delivery to AWE.



Access to storage compartments must be made available. Delivery will be refused if no key is available.



A maximum load of 1 x 10ltr or 2 x 5ltr of petrol fuel in metal fuel containers is permitted.



The appropriate certification and permits must be provided for any Mechanical handling equipment.
